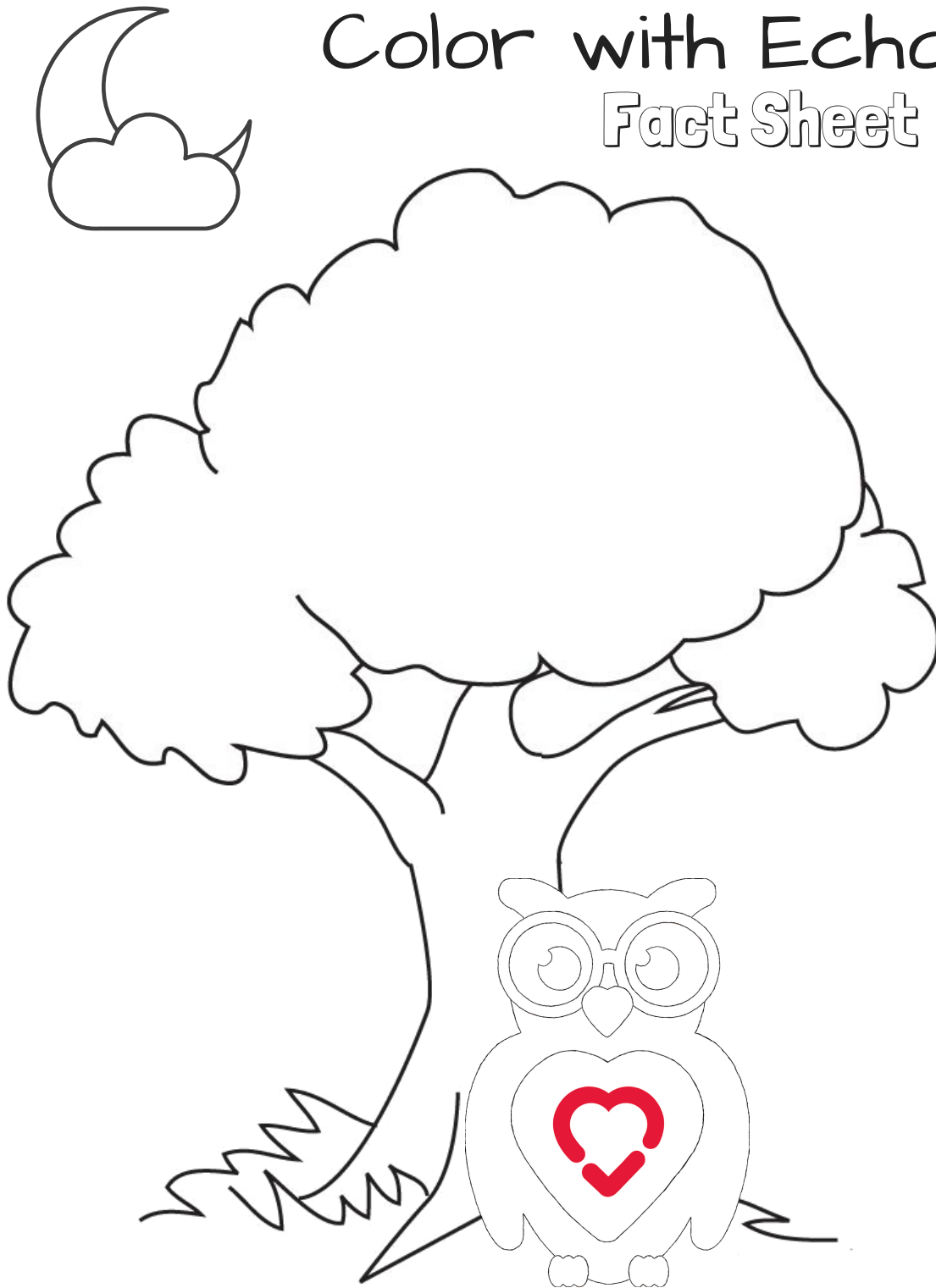


Color with Echo Fact Sheet



Congenital Heart Disease
is the most common birth defect

1 in 100 newborns are born with CHD

40,000 infants
are born in the US each year with CHD

There is an estimated 2.4 million people
living with CHD

25% of children born with CHD need heart
surgery or other interventions to survive

There is no cure

CHD is a lifelong disease
requiring ongoing specialized care

Fewer than 10% of adults with CHD
are receiving recommended care

Costs for hospitalizations related to congenital
heart disease were more than \$6 billion in 2013.
